
## We asked Ozan Musluoğlu:



# Jiango Reinhardt and Stéphane Grappelli

Django Reinhardt was born in 1910 in Belgium to a Romani family. He taught himself how to play musical instruments. At the age of 18, the caravan he was living in caught fire and he suffered burns on the fourth and fifth fingers of his left hand. Despite the doctors' prognosis that he wouldn't be able to play the guitar again, he adapted his technique to his new condition and continued playing. After the accident, Django began to pursue American jazz.

Stéphane Grappelli was born in 1908 in Paris. Having lost his mother at a very young age, Stéphane grew up in an orphanage. Before he was 10 years old, he had already taught himself how to play the violin. When he was 13, his father sent him to the Paris Conservatory. By the time he was 15, he was playing music on the streets and in cafes.

In 1934 Django and Stéphane met each other and set up the band called Quintette Hot Club de France. This band was the first great jazz band to emerge in Europe.
